

## English

This term, the children will read 'The Firework Makers Daughter' by Phillip Pullman. They will explore the vivid vocabulary used in the story, and learn how to write description and dialogue. Children will write their own adventure stories, recounts and poems. They will also spend time learning grammar, spelling and punctuation rules.

## Maths

In Maths, the children will continue learning all about fractions followed by our unit on time. After this, the children will explore the angles and properties of different shapes. Following on from this the children will build on their understanding of mass and capacity. The children will also continue to work on their Times Tables Travels

## Science

The children will begin by exploring different rocks and soils and learning how they are formed using scientific investigation and comparison. They will also explore plants, investigating the functions of a range of plants, what they need in order to grow and the flower life cycle.

## DT

The children will make and decorate a fabric product. They will learn a range of joining and sewing techniques.



## PE

Children will develop their balance and agility, as well as learning striking and fielding games.

## Geography

In Geography the children will be exploring the topic of Mountains, Volcanos and Earthquakes. They will learn how mountains are formed and what causes a volcano to erupt. They will also discover the cause and effect of earthquakes. Moving on, the children will learn to compare the geographical features of two different landscapes, Dartmoor and the South of Italy, identifying their similarities and differences.

## French

In French we are learning how to ask people's ages and respond, how to use articles correctly in French and how to say commands.

## PSHE

The children will be learning about relationships with other people and about how their bodies change on the inside and outside.

## Art

The children will learn about the artist, David Hockney and create paintings and digital media, in the style of the artist.

## Computing

In Computing, the children will be looking at a range of data-bases and using Purple Mash to create a database about their subject of choice.

## RE

In RE the children will explore the significance of sharing in the Sikh religion and the importance of the River Ganges to Hindus
